

ARTIST REGISTRATION & REQUIREMENTS

- **When the registration site is opened, a link will appear on the Friends of the Arboretum "Art in the Arboretum" page.**
- Registration deadline - **Friday, September 18, 2015.**
- All Artists must register online.
- Online registration is a new process introduced to make the procedure easier and more efficient for the artists.
- Questions regarding process or requirements may be emailed to Maria Williams, Polly Smith or Alice Wilson. (See contact information on back page).
- We encourage you to register as early as possible.

This show is open to both professional and emerging artists 18 years of age or older.

Representative Art will be Juried

- Art is juried by committee.
- Accepted artists will be posted online by **September 25, 2015.**
- The Artists Committee reserves the right to remove work from the show deemed inappropriate.

Sales Procedures

- The Friends of the Arboretum will retain a commission of 30% on all art sold during the show.
- All sales will be handled through the Arboretum.

2-D ART

Two dimensional Paintings, Photography, Drawings, Prints, Textiles, Banners

- A maximum of three pieces of framed art may be displayed at one time. Sold pieces may be replaced by an additional work.
- All 2-D art must be **completely prepared for hanging with wire**. Saw tooth hangers will not be accepted.
- Plexiglas must be used in place of glass to cover works greater than 30" in any direction
- Gallery-wrapped canvases must have finished edges.

BIN WORK

- Maximum of 10 pieces.
- **Black canvas bins (only)** must be provided by artists.
- Work needs to be clean, properly backed (foam core or mat board) and protected with shrink wrap or crystal bags.
- Label bin work with title, artist name, medium and price.
- When delivering artwork on Tuesday, September 29, provide an inventory with titles and prices on a 4X6 index card with artist name, email and phone number.

REPRODUCTIONS MUST BE LABELED AS SUCH

Participating artists are encouraged to spend as much time as possible at the show. No one can sell your work as well as you.

Registered artists are welcome and encouraged to paint "en plein air" during the show.

3-D ART

Three dimensional Ceramics, Sculpture, Glass, Metal, Stone, Wood, Textiles, Jewelry

- Quantity is determined upon jurying.
- **All 3-D** artists must provide an inventory with titles & prices.
- Label work with title, artist name, medium and price.
- **Outdoor 3-D** artists must set up their own installation with guidance from volunteers
- **Outdoor 3-D** artists are required to be present with their work during show hours
- **Jewelers and textile** artists must be present during show times and provide own display.

Artist with Disabilities

- The Ability Garden hosts a show within the show, specifically for artists with disabilities.

Friday - September 18th

- Deadline for required online registration. Early registration is encouraged.
- Jpeg(s) representation of artwork due with registration.

Tuesday – September 29th

- Bring 2-D artwork to the Arboretum ready for hanging between 9:00am & 12:00 noon

Thursday – October 1st

- Bring 3-D artwork to the Arboretum between 9:00am & 12:00 noon.

Friday – October 2nd

- Show times 10:00 – 6:00
- Admission \$5.00

Saturday – October 3rd

- Show times 10:00 – 4:00
- Admission \$5.00

- The Friends of the Arboretum Party 4:30 – 7:00. No charge for Artists. Artists' guest must purchase tickets - \$15.00 in advance or \$20.00 at the door.

Sunday – October 4th

- Show times 10:00 – 4:00
- Admission \$5.00
- Unsold Art must be picked-up between 4:30-5:30 pm. The Arboretum and Wilmington Art Association are not responsible for artwork left after this time.
- Art must remain on display until 4:30 to allow time for customers to complete purchases & for the sales desk to complete artists check-out.
